Proposal for signing MOU with the IIGST and Mahindra CSR

Resolution:

a. Proposal for signing MOU with the IIGST

The IQAC Coordinator placed a proposal from the department of Geography for signing a MOU between the college and the International Institute of Geospatial Institute of Science & Technology [IIGST] for running specialized courses. The members have gone through the proposal and felt that running such courses will be beneficial for the students of the institution. Hence it is unanimously resolved that the college will sign a MOU with the IIGST and the department of Geography will be in charge of successful implementation of the project. Further resolved that the department of Geography will be asked to go through the merit of each course and the mode of implementation and place a report to the IQAC before signing of the MOU.

b. Proposal for signing MOU Mahindra CSR

The IQAC Coordinator placed a proposal of Mahindra CSR for signing a MOU with the college for implementation of Employability Skills Training Programme for final year passed out students . The members have gone through the proposal in details and found that the organization has MoU the Director of Technical Education WB, and West Bengal University of Health Sciences and other reputed organisations. Hence the members felt that signing up of MOU with them will be beneficial for the institution. The proposal is unanimously accepted.

Resolutions:

1. The Coordinator informed the house that Bajaj Finserv, an Indian non-banking financial services

company has expressed interest in arranging a campus recruitment drive for their company, in the college. All the members welcomed the proposal and it is decided that the program will be arranged under the aegis of the Placement Cell.

- 2. Dr Bablee Mandal suggested that all the activities of the cells and the departments should ideally be conducted after 2 pm without affecting the class schedule. All the members welcomed the suggestion and it is unanimously decided that henceforth, unless exceptional circumstances, all the programs will be organized, after 2 pm. It is also resolved further that allotment roster will be introduced in arranging programs in the two seminar halls of the college: the SKSMH and KCPMSH.
- 3. It is resolved that 6 rooms will be converted into ICT enabled rooms with the installation of latest interactive panels.
- 4. The Central Bharat Sevak Samaj's proposal for running job-oriented courses in the college is unanimously rejected as the house felt that the implementation of the proposal will not serve the interest of the college.
