4. The parties wish to formalize their collaboration by entering into this MoU to outline their respective roles and responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

**1. Provision of Health Facilities:**

- a. SHH agrees to provide FREE necessary health facilities, medical check-ups, and healthcare services excluding First Aid and Emergency services to the students of Surya Sen Mahavidyalaya during the term of this MoU.
- b. SHH recognizes the importance of extending healthcare support to the extended community of the Institution. Therefore, SHH shall also provide necessary health care facilities to the parents and legal guardians of the students enrolled at the Institution. These facilities shall encompass a wide range of medical and surgical treatments, including the management of complicated health issues such as cancer.
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**2. Universal Membership Subscription:**

The Institution undertakes to ensure that all its students become Universal Members of SHH by subscribing yearly at the rate of ₹10 (Indian Rupees Ten only) per student.

**3. Term and Termination:**

a. This MoU shall be in effect for a period of 01 year (one) starting from the 1st Day of April, 2023 and shall continue in full force and effect until 31st Day of March, 2024 unless terminated earlier in mutual agreement in writing or for cause as provisions herein.

b. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice of 90 days to the other party.

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

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
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
