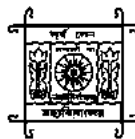




A total number of 596 participants were present in both Google Meet and YouTube platform including teachers, students, laboratory staffs from various colleges, industrialists across the country and abroad.



5. My mood often swings because of Lack of consistency in studies as examinations are taken Online which is not giving me expected marks as evaluation is done on average basis.
6. I got mentally stressed because of cancellation and postponed of examination notice coming frequently from university .7. How to find the simple way towards the target or goals of our life in this pandemic situation?
8. How can we improve our concentration level during this pandemic situation?
9. Financial Problems of the family are making us disturbed.
10. Impact of the corona has made my fitness worst and nowadays I feel more lazy and tired.

11. Insufficient supply of vaccine is making me more depressed as chances of getting infected becomes more.
12. How do we cope with the uncertainty regarding our career and future?
13. Is it possible to avoid depression only through a healthy lifestyle, if not then how can we do?
14. How will this new strain of coronavirus affect youths?
15. My behavior is sometimes getting bad like moody which makes my family members affected, please help me.

Sri Ritabrata Biswas, Curator and Project coordinator of North Bengal Science Centre, Matigara was the resource person for the webinar. His presentation was highly appreciated and was requested by the participants to conduct one more session in the coming days. The workshop ended with a vote of gratitude by Dr. Sanchita Das, the other coordinator of the workshop and language lab.

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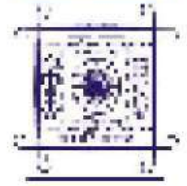
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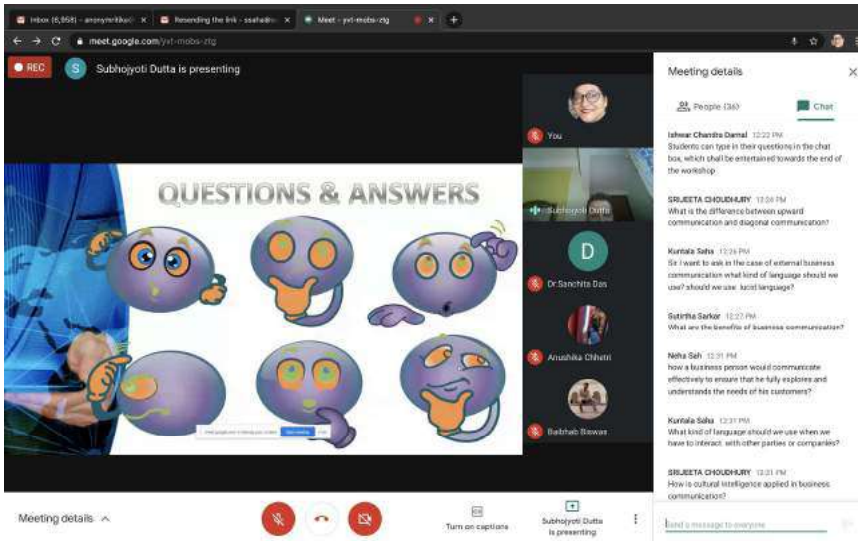

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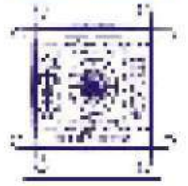

### Report on the ICSSR sponsored National Webinar on “Society, Disaster and Resilience: Lessons from Literature”

A one day ICSSR sponsored National webinar on “Society, disaster and Resilience: Lessons from Literature” was organized by the Department of English of Surya Sen Mahavidyalaya on 8th February, 2021 from 10.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. The objective of the webinar was to look back at the oeuvre of literature across genres that deals with the diverse socio-political and cultural issues generated by a time of crisis such as epidemics and disasters and try to contemplate on the narratives which can restore humanity’s faith at the face of great calamities. The program was conducted on Cisco WebEx platform along with YouTube live streaming. The webinar was divided into three consecutive sessions- inaugural session, technical session 1 and technical session 2.

The inaugural session of the webinar began with an elaborate introductory note by the convener Dr. Arnab Baul who introduced the objective of the webinar. Next a warm welcome address was delivered to the participants by the Principal of SSM, Dr. P. K. Mishra. It was followed by the inaugural comments forwarded by the joint convener and Head of the Department of English, Prof. Sutapa saha. The webinar was officially inaugurated with the speech delivered by Dr. Jaydeep Sarangi, Principal of New Alipore College, Kolkata, who addressed the audience with his introspective speech about the emergency caused by the pandemic and the reflection of the same in literature. Then an elaborate Keynote speech was presented by Dr. Abhijit Sen, Professor of Department of English and Other Modern European Languages, Visva Bharati University. Dr. Sen discussed at length about the widespread existence of epidemics and black death during the era of the Middle Ages. Two resource persons were invited to deliver lectures on this program. The first invited lecture was delivered by Dr. Debarshi Prasad Nath, Professor of Department of Cultural Studies from Tezpur University and the topic of his deliberation was “The Ethics of Uncertainty during Disasters”. The second invited lecture was delivered by Dr. Binayak Roy, Assistant Professor of English Department from North Bengal University. Dr. Binayak’s topic of discussion was “Precarity in Transit: Migrant Labour in Amitabh Ghosh’s Novels”. The first part of the session, thus, ends at 1 p.m. followed by the lunch break. The inaugural session was hosted by Prof. Puja Mahajan.

The first technical session was monitored by the session chair Dr. Amitabh Roy, Vice Principal and Associate Professor of Alipurduar Mahila Mahavidyalaya. It was followed by the paper presentation section where 14 participants presented their papers. After that a discussion took place between the presenters and the session chair regarding the papers. The second technical session was monitored by Dr. Joydeep Bhattacharya, Associate Professor of the Department of English from Kurseong College. In the second phase of paper presentation 16 papers were delivered followed by a discussion session. After the presentations and discussions, a valedictory address was proposed by Prof. Sutapa Saha, Head of the English Department. Finally the seminar came to an end with the vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Sanchita Das. The technical session, however, was hosted by Prof. Ishwar Chandra Darnal.

The webinar turned out to be a fruitful endeavor on part of the English Department to provide a platform to participants who brought about their critical perspectives and understanding from the genre of pandemic literature. A diverse range of literary narratives was presented and discussed well during the webinar. 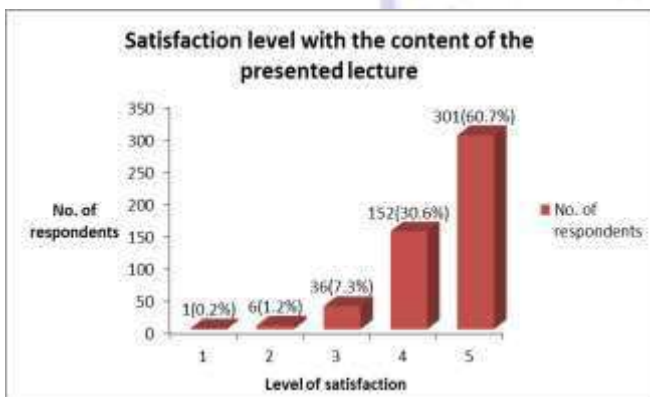

- **Origin and growth of Urban Settlement: A case study of Siliguri.**

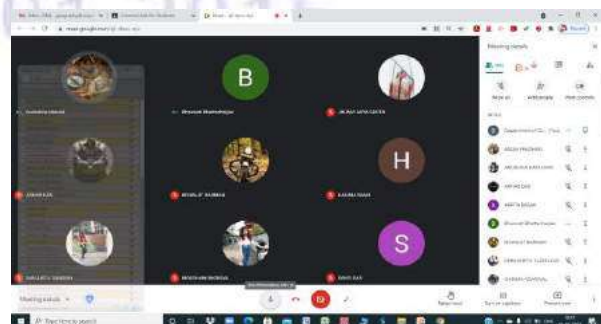
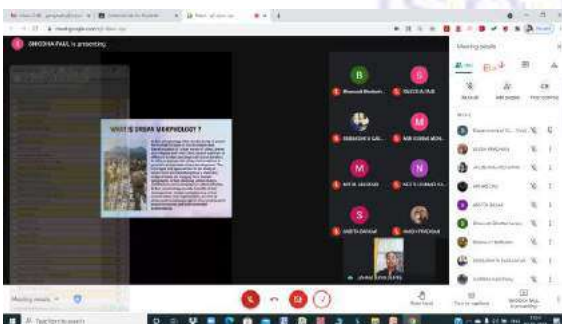
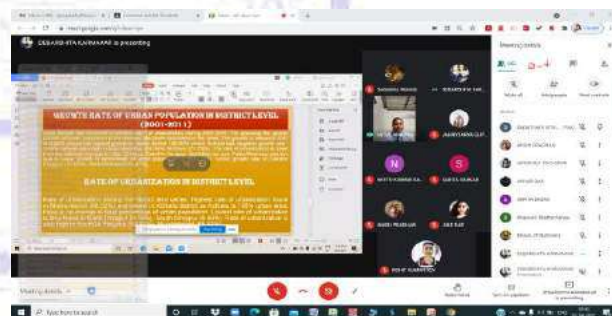
They explained the definition of urban settlement. They also described the origin, growth, and history and evolution process of Siliguri town broadly one by one.

Students of this group described about the concept and structure of urban morphology. Then they illustrated about the origin, growth and morphological structure of Chandigarh City.

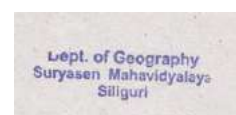
- **Urbanization and Urban growth: A study of West Bengal.**

- **Evaluation and Development of Geographical thoughts in medieval period.**

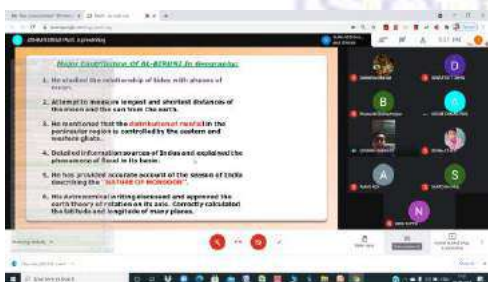
They explained about the evaluation process of geographical thoughts in medieval period first then gave a detailed view of development history through different ages in medieval period.

Every year National Science Day is observed nationwide to commemorate the discovery of Raman Effect by Sir C. V. Raman on February 28, 1928. # Be Heart Healthy

An awareness program on heart health

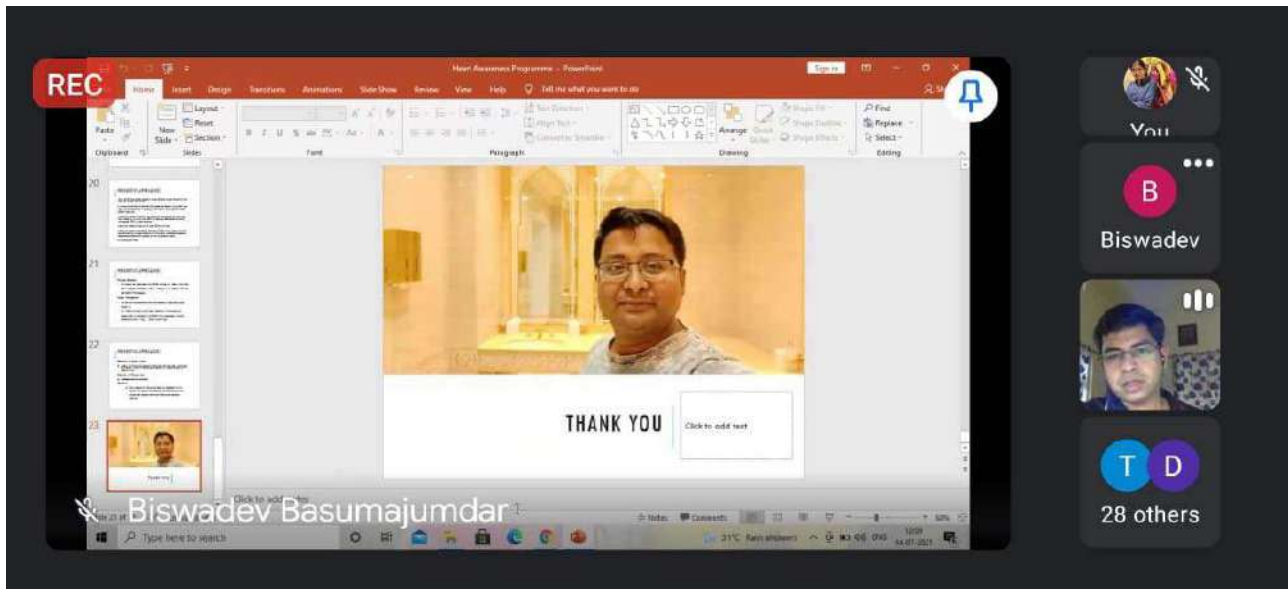
A general awareness programme on heart health was organized by the Department of Physics on 04.07.2021 during 05:00 – 06:15 PM. The targeted audience was the general public. The programme was an online presentation (webinar) delivered by Dr. Biswadev Basu Majumdar, Senior Consultant Interventional Cardiologist, Desun Hospital, Siliguri. Welcome address was delivered by Dr. Arindam Karmakar followed by a formal inaugural speech by Principal, Dr. Pranab Kumar Mishra. This was followed by the main session, the presentation by the speaker. There was a brief question answer session after this. The programme was then concluded by a vote of thanks by Dr. Romyani Goswami, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics. There were about 48 participants in the audience that included some from our college, some from outside and within West Bengal and a couple of them outside West Bengal.

The main session was very rich and informative about various aspects of heart physiology, diseases, diagnosis, prognosis and preventive measures. The seminar started with a brief and general overview of the heart as an organ of the human body and its various functions, followed by different risk factors of heart diseases. All possible common signs and symptoms of heart disease were then discussed in very lucid terms for awareness of the general people. Different broad classifications of heart diseases were then distinguished along with highlighting the major, the most common and the most dangerous ones and how to identify them in cases of emergencies. The motivation was to educate the common people about them, so that they can understand the importance of such symptoms and take the right emergency steps for any patient, at any time, outside the hospital, and rush them for medical treatments. The presentation also included description of common diagnostic methods in practice and the common treatment methods prevailing at present. The audience was also educated about several varieties of pacemakers available today and in which cases each one of them is used. Some illustrative videos of pacemaker implantation and pacemakers in action were also shown to give the audience a taste of the practical scenario. Lastly, and most importantly, there were discussions of medically recommended practices to be maintained in daily life for prevention of heart diseases. Overall, as the

major objective of the program, we believe that a general awareness of heart health was rightly achieved among the participants. We hope that we could educate the audience, with a scientific background, about the importance of heart in human body, its functions, how to keep it healthy, what are the dangers of heart diseases, how to identify them, how to act in cases of heart emergencies, how to help people with sudden and emergency heart problems, what are the first aids to be followed, how heart diseases are diagnosed and rectified.

2. **Martensitic transition assisted modification of the magnetic structure in magnetic equiatomic alloys**

**Brief abstract:** Magnetic equiatomic alloys (MEAs) of general formula  $MM'X$  ( $M, M'$  = transition metals,  $X$  = Si, Ge, Sn, etc.) have been identified as the new shape memory alloys. Apart from the shape memory effect, these alloys are particularly important for their various promising functional properties, including the large magnetocaloric effect, magnetoresistance, the exchange bias effect, etc. The magnetic structure of MEAs, both in martensite and austenite phases, are playing a pivotal role



in the observation of interesting functional properties. Neutron diffraction studies reveal the detailed magnetic structure of both martensite and austenite phases. The diffusionless martensitic transition was found to show a significant influence on the magnetic structure of these materials.

### 3. **Discovery of Weyl Fermions in Band Topology**

**Brief abstract:** The discoveries of topological phases of matter open up a new avenue of research where the role of mesoscopic effects becomes as dominant as that of topology. This leads to the investigation of predicted topological states, with a large number of protecting symmetries, edge state structures and other striking physical properties such as absence of backscattering and ultrahigh electron mobility, quantum oscillations, negative magnetoresistance originating from chiral anomalies, nonlocal transport, non-Abelian statistics, spin-momentum locking and associated superconductivity. The existence of the topological “*Fermi-arc*” surface states are the hallmark of realizing the Weyl Fermions in condensed matter physics in both the inversion and time reversal symmetry broken semimetals. In this lecture, the discovery of Weyl Fermions will be discussed and the interplay between surface and bulk states will be shown in terms of the two extremes: the protection and the manipulation of the topological states that are attributed to different penetration depths of the Fermi arcs into the bulk.

### 4. **Decoding exotic frustrated magnetism using extreme-condition-magnetometry**

**Brief abstract:** In this webinar, I plan to demonstrate how magnetometric study performed under extreme conditions of temperature and magnetic field could serve as a powerful tool in discovering highly non-trivial spin-states in frustrated magnets. To illustrate the topic, I will present example of a new frustrated quantum magnet called BHAP-Ni<sub>3</sub> and will show how magnetometry performed in the milli-kelvin regime using very strong magnetic field unfolded existence of an exotic spin-state of quantum origin.

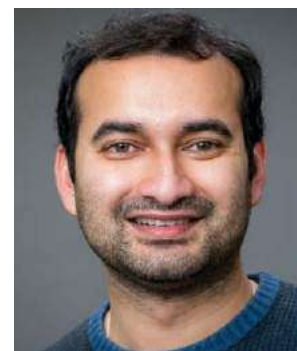

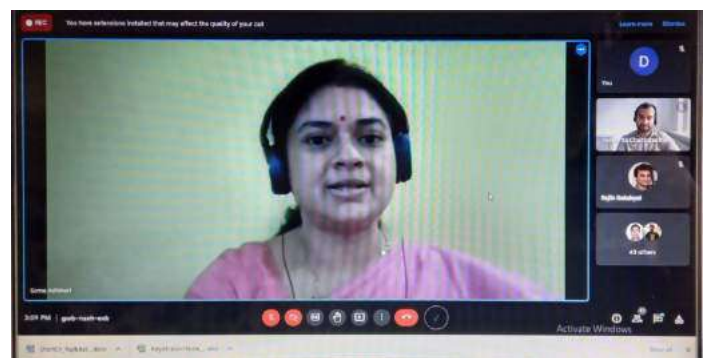
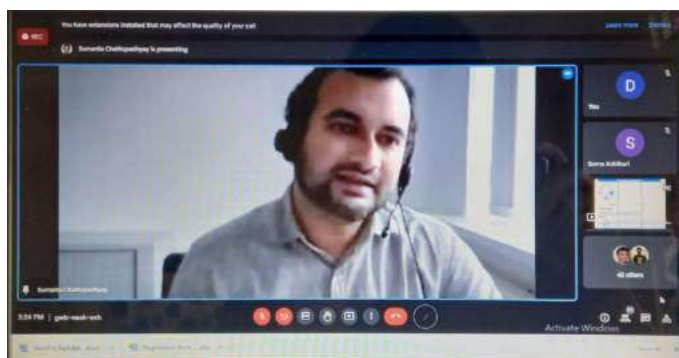
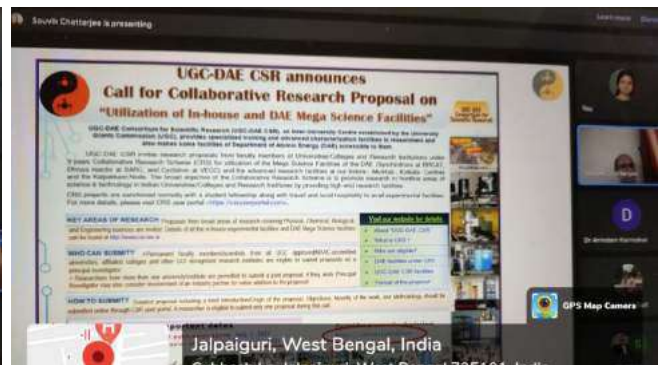
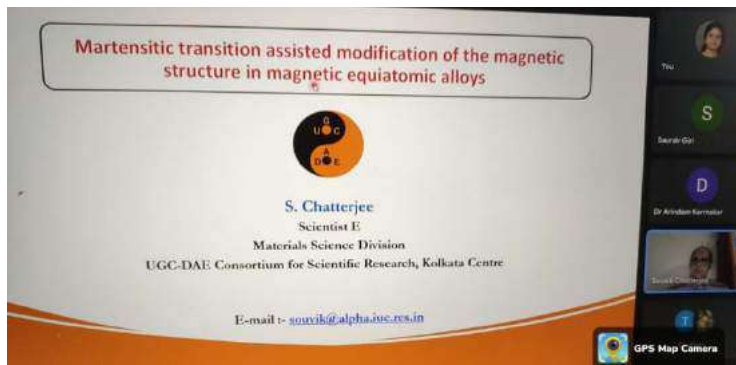
## Brief summary of the event:

The program started in time with the introduction of the convener. The principal, Dr. Pranab Kumar Mishra then delivered the welcome address followed by address of the IQAC coordinator, Dr. Arnab Baul. Immediately after this, the first session was started and chaired by Dr. Arindam Karmakar. Two detailed presentations were delivered as per schedule with brief discussion sessions after each. The first presentation by Dr. Saurav Giri dealt with many fundamental understanding of magnetism in materials both in the bulk and the nano-scale followed by citations of several examples. The fundamental topics spurred a lot of interest in the audience. The next presentation dealt with the interesting shape memory properties of some alloys and their low temperature

(up to 2 K) characterizations using several advanced tools like squid magnetometer, PPMS and neutron diffraction. This unboxed many new ideas and information to the audience. This was followed by a one hour lunch break. During the second half, the presentations were delivered by experts from abroad, as detailed above. The third presentation was the most brilliant presentation of the day that described a school of blazing hot topics in physics such as topological states, ultrahigh electron mobility, quantum oscillations, negative magnetoresistance, superconductivity, Weyl fermions in 2D materials fabricated using a Scanning Tunneling Microscope. There was a detailed discussion following this which continued into the prospects of the research in the development of quantum computer. The fourth and the last presentation discussed several super-advanced experimental tools in modern day solid state physics that allow experiments in extremely low temperatures (milli-kelvin range) and extremely high magnetic fields (nearly 100 tesla and above). The lecture also demonstrated application of these tools using an interesting discovery of a spin-state of quantum origin in a new material. All the presentations were very successful in dissemination of several ideas and information about many interesting and contemporary phenomena in magnetism of materials and also in demonstrating several new advanced techniques of materials characterization used these days all over the world. ## Seminar Theme

### REVISITING MARXISM ON MARX'S BICENTENNIAL BIRTH ANNIVERSARY (1818-2018)

Thoughts of Karl Marx (1818-1883) and Frederick Engels (1820-1895) expressed through their writings extended over a period of almost five decades constitute a body of opinions on a large spectrum of subjects—politics, economics, sociology, culture, history, philosophy, literature, and science, known as Marxism. Whereas writings of John Locke or José Ortega y Gasset end in a blind lane—no matter whether an activist or an academic takes that to work with in his/her respective field, that hardly ever appear as an ideology influencing larger masses. Marxism is a thoroughly different body of theories: something that is ever active as an ideology among the greater public on the streets and as an agenda in the academic institutions—for good or for bad. While Marx has been selected the man of the millennium by the mass media, Marxism remain debated, declared “dead”, and then again brought to the fore of intellectual discourse during the 150 years since the publication of the *Capital* vol. I. In sharp contrast, Francis Fukuyama, who had found the “End of History” in the 1990s, had to swallow back and declare the end of his proposition within two decades.

Looking at the academic arena, Marx's thoughts and works have been willy-nilly syllabified—in the graduate/post graduate courses or as an endless source of Ph. D. themes, and to that extent form an institutional resource material for the academia on a vast scale. It is possible to argue for or against, but not ignore Marxism.

**Standing in between the bicentenary years of birth of these two stalwarts of the nineteenth century, Marx and Engels, it may therefore be worthwhile to take a fresh stock of the system of thoughts they offered to the world. We, therefore, arrange some discourses on different areas of intellection to see how far their ideas may still prove relevant in a practical way.**

## **Marxism in the USSR: A Critical Evaluation**

Understanding Marxism in the USSR involves two central questions: (a) intellectual origins of Marxism in pre-revolutionary Russia (Plekhanov) and the tradition that it set in the interpretation of Marx. (b) While it is this current that dominated the practice of socialism in the USSR and became the synonym of official Marxism, was there any alternative understanding of Marxism that questioned the official position but remained marginalized? A brief account of how Marxism developed in pre-revolutionary Russia: from Plekhanov to Lenin.
2. Lenin and Soviet socialism: new interpretations (Lars Lih). Contributions of David Ryazanov in the dissemination of Marxism in the USSR- Lenin as a philosopher and a theorist of socialism in the context of transition from War Communism to NEP. An overview of the debate in Soviet philosophy in the 20s: Deborin vs his adversaries and the eventual marginalization of Deborin. Early Bukharin: an assessment. The Soviet debate on history: Pokrovsky and his opponents. Soviet Marxism in the post-Lenin era-Emergence of an alternative understanding of Marxism and its fate. The late Bukharin and the Marxism of his Prison Manuscripts- The fate of Ryazanov and the role of Academician Mitin and his associates and followers in the canonization of official Marxism. Marxism in the Stalin period: an assessment.
3. Soviet Marxism in the post-War period; from 20<sup>th</sup> Congress of Soviet Communist Party (1956) to the advent of the Gorbachev era: from relative openness to stagnation: an overview. Three basic issues that engaged the attention of Soviet Marxism: (a) understanding Marx in the light of the ongoing debate on alienation in the Western world; (b) encountering problems of building socialism in the

USSR: the issues of ethnicity and religion through the lens of class; (c) responding to the Western Marxists' critique of Soviet Marxism.

4. Soviet Marxism in the era of *glasnost* and *perestroika*: opening of new frontiers in the development of Marxism amidst heated debates and controversies, the focal point being how socialism was built in the USSR. Reassessment of the past and critical re-evaluation of how Marxism had developed in the Soviet Union. Concluding observations.

Professor S Datta Gupta has an abiding interest in the political and intellectual history of Marxism. Some of his remarkable works are: 1. ***Comintern, India and the Colonial Question, 1920-37*** (1980), 2. ***Comintern and the Destiny of Communism in India 1919-1943: Dialectics of Real and a Possible History*** (2011-Second Ed) (translated into German and Malayalam languages also), 3. ***The Ryutin Platform: Stalin and the crisis of proletarian dictatorship: platform of the 'Union of Marxists-Leninists'*** (2012), 4. ***Marxism in Dark Times: Select Essays for the New Century*** (2012), 5. **সমাজ, মার্ক্সতত্ত্ব ও সমকালঃ নির্বাচিত প্রবন্ধ** (2013) , 6. ***The Socialist Vision and the Silenced Voices of Democracy- New Perspectives: Rosa Luxemburg*** (2015), 7. ***The Socialist Vision and the Silenced Voices of Democracy- New Perspectives: Nikolai Bukharin*** (2019) etc.

He is currently working on George Lukacs- the remaining volume of the series: *The Socialist Vision and the Silenced Voices of Democracy*.

So far it seems to have stemmed from, and to be able to address to, a political structure, which is basically monochromatic in socio-ethnic demographic composition of the population involved, namely Europe. Marxism, with its emphasis on class as the basic socio-economic analytical tool, is supposed to be quite successful in that context. But in a country like India, with a single national unity in political administrative terms, but a polychromatic and multilayered structure and polity in terms of socio-ethnic demographic composition of its population (i. e., the vast widespread array of castes and tribes), Marxism appears to have failed to address the emerging issues. I intend to thoroughly re-examine this assumption in terms of theoretical premise as well as practical consequences, especially in view of the rising precarious situation in the country.

Sri Ashoke Mukhopadhyay is a popular science writer, works on history, sociology and philosophy of sciences. He has to his credit a number of publications: Both in Bengali & English. He also contributes articles regularly in various journals. 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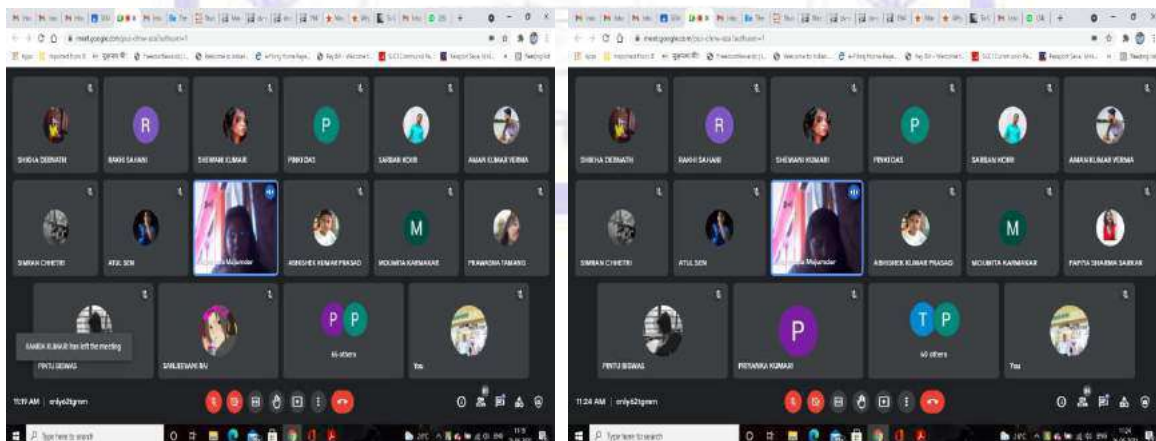


**Invited Lectures: Dept of Political Science: June 10 & 26, 2021**
