## ENVIRONMENT, PEACE AND MORALITY: EAST AND WEST

Robert Oppenheimer, the “father of the atomic bomb” watched the first test detonation of an atomic bomb in the New Mexico desert with horror, recalling a phrase from the Bhagavad Gita: “ Now I am become Death, the destroyer of the worlds”. The implication of the verse resonates through the years since. The nature of human fallibility has led to the unprecedented increase in our powers which is the cause of destruction of life on a world-wide scale. Pollution of sea, air and land, species loss, hazard posed by modern armaments, nuclear weaponry, all appear as potential terminal threats to Planet Earth, and its inhabitants. This calls for an urgency to examine not only the underlying socio-political structures, but also a flawed sense of anthropocentric moral reasoning that work against our intimacy with nature and thwart the development of a sustainable society. The connections between environmental issues and conflict are complex. Environmental factors are linked to violent conflict in variety of ways that is often obscured by more visible issues. The thematic focus of the seminar emerge from a conviction that a better understanding of the link between environmental change and human well-being is vital for effective conflict prevention ensuring peace and security. For this purpose, we need to shift our focus from reformist environmental policies to a deep ecoactivism, which will offer normative critique of human activity and institutions to ensure a fundamental change in the dominant worldview and social structure of modernity. Unlike conventional environmentalism which begins with a dichotomy between human beings and their natural environment, we need to uphold an alternative philosophy of nature, highlighting the fact that humankind cannot flourish unless nature flourishes as a whole. It is now imperative to bring about a revolution in our thought process, a maneuvering of our consciousness and fashioning of a moral reasoning where the confluence of oriental and occidental traditions of critical thoughts, on matters related to environment and peace-building, can open up new trajectories of introspection.
