

Objective: The objective of organizing students' seminar is to encourage them about their communication skill, to develop their subject knowledge by discussion amongst them & with the teachers.



They explained the definition of urban settlement. They also described the origin, growth, and history and evolution process of Siliguri town broadly one by one.


· Urban Morphology of Chandigarh City.
