# College imparts self-defence skills among girl students

Surya Sen Mahavidyalaya in Siliguri has started imparting self-defense training for girl students.

The training, which kicked off yesterday, was a longpending dream of the college, officials said. So far, 168 students have expressed their interest in learning the self-defense skills, while it will take them a full three months to complete the basic course.

"The NSS Unit-II of the college had conducted such a training camp at Jabravita, an adopted village, near Siliguri, a few days ago, where 60 girls were trained in self-defense skills," said the Programme Officer of the NSS Unit-II, Babita Prasad.
