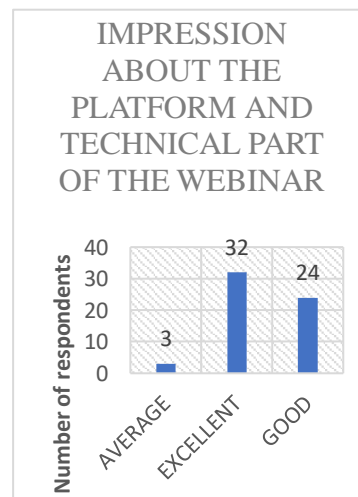
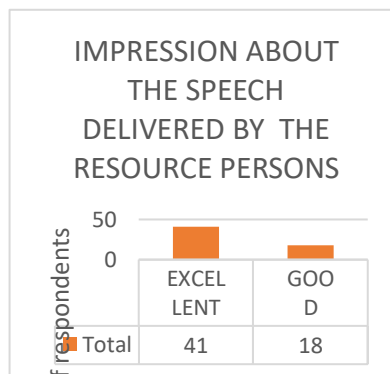
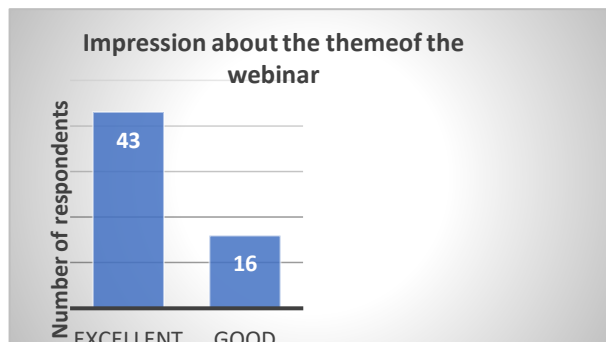
Report of the Webinar:

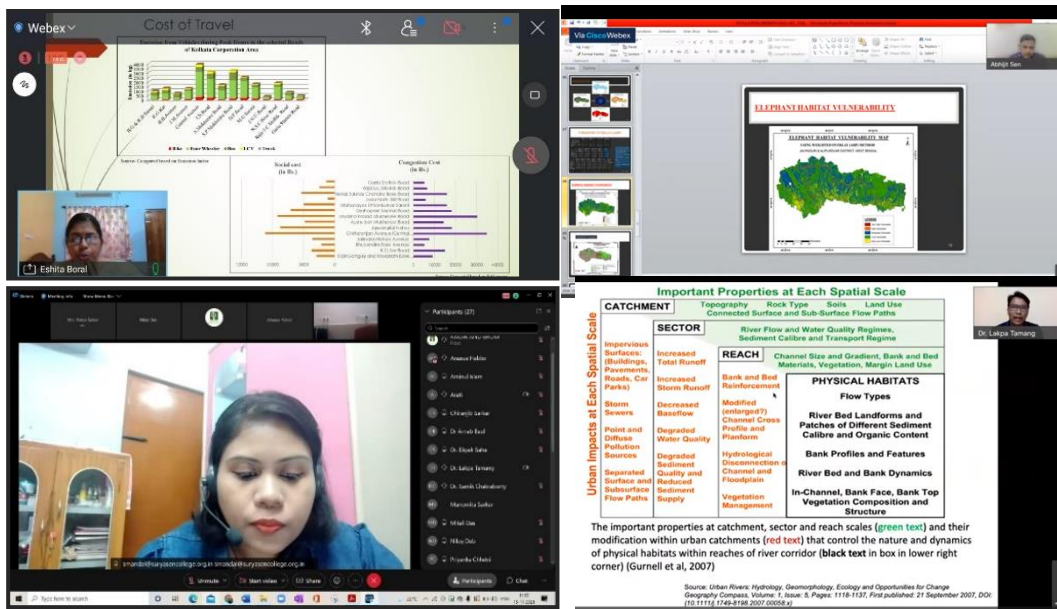
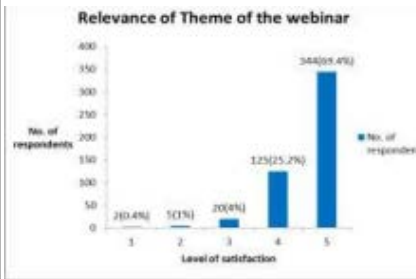
